During his he studied abroad, Soseki decided to read the famous books that he knew the title but that he had not yet read. Among his classmates there were: Tsuneners Masaoka (whose pseudonym is Shiki Masaoka and who later became a nu nu ennevid otiuges ni ehc( adamaY oratuB ,)osoiduts onu ennevid ehc( atakaniM usugamuK, )ukiah Yaichi Haga (who also became a scholar of Japanese literature). ("The morning of September 14') was September 19, 1902 (Meiji 35), only a few days after this essay, when Shiki A died. Yet it is clear that many harmful influences can be brought to our nation when we develop a trait to promote the inclination of all scholars only to become doctors or when they act on the basis of this kind of extreme tendency. [...] After my return, I was still treated as the crazy person who had a nervous breakdown. (Sanshiro) In many respects, A" "sorekara" (and then). However, Shiki retired and chose to live his life. Since I entered the hospital in Kobe, I have had a tendency to cry. I didn't even feel like I woke up. Then, he made it appear in Hototogisu. Yet this Roku-shaku A is still too spacious for me." This serialization continued<sup>2</sup> until shortly before the day of his death. You have a vision and you decide to lead your life. For Shiki, the fact that his writings had appeared in newspapers and magazines was nothing more than the proof of her life. Soseki's disciple, Torahiko Terada, recalls Soseki and Shiki as follows: the topic moved from Soseki's situation to Kumamoto to the voices on the master Soseki, and I hear the stories about their school days. On the other hand, Shiki wrote: I like the company and you don't like the company. Last spring, I remember a little after the happiness week, I planted packs of seeds that sent me Dr. Ogai. I didn't have free time to read, even if I haven't read many books from the first. It is said that the person who took the efforts to invite Kokichi Kano to the 5th High School as a professor was Soseki. For this and other reasons, immediately after my birth my parents asked me to rely on me and sent me there. That's why history has no plot nor developments of events. (A speech on 'My Kusamakura': Speaking of Soseki in this period of composition, Kyoko, his wife, speaks as follows: even if he had no intention of Writing professional novels had long suppressed his feeling of wanting to write something. Apart from the English literature, this way of learning does not allow us to understand above all that is literature. Keeping exactly the same posture, I looked out through the shoji glass (the Japanese sliding door). Shiki, on May 3, presented the first daughter of Soseki Fudeko with three Hina-ningyos (dolls dressed with the old representative Kimonos of the people in court). From the day when Mona appeared in the newspaper to date, nobody told me anything about it. Recently I always cry more times. Everything that they say is true. In April of the same year, she took the position of English teacher as part-time employee of the first high school and another as an English teacher of Tokyo Imperial University. Soseki wrote Shiki the letter that seemed to allude his love to a woman: "By the way, I went to the oculist yesterday. From my childhood till now, the pleasure that accompanies wild flowers sometimes makes me feel as if I were God.' ('My sense of beauty as a child': Waga voji no bikan) For Shiki, who was unable to rise up because of his illness, 'the small garden of 66£ÂA; A. Considering that that sort of satire is perfectly proper to the present day, I represented it in the story of the cat. I do not anticipate it, so my face reddened" (The letter to Shiki on 18 July 1891) Shiki in school days (1890) On September 1890, Soseki entered the Department of English Literature at the Tokyo Imperial University, and Shiki the Department of September 1890, Soseki entered the Department of Lagranese Literature). They had me read the poem or phrases in front of him and also write compositions, and then I was scolded by him for omitting articles or mispronouncing the words.
